Re: Notification of Asbestos Inspection and Management Plan Availability

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires all schools conduct detailed inspections to identify all asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) that may be present in the school environment. AHERA requires the inspection results and the associated Management Plan be submitted to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ). A copy of the Management Plan must be maintained at the administrative office for review by the public.

South Fork Junior High School maintains a proactive asbestos awareness program. The architect responsible for the construction of the school has provided a letter stating that to the best of his knowledge, no asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) was used at this school.
